

END OF TENANCY cleaning checklist

TO-DO



Kitchen



Cupboards and worktops

Wipe inside, outside and underneath, including doors and handles. Clean backsplash thoroughly, ensuring no grease is stuck to tiles. Wipe plugs and wall sockets (ENSURE ALL ARE TURNED OFF FIRST!).



Oven

Pull out all internal shelves and trays and use an off-the-shelf oven cleaner (i.e. OvenPride): you should be able to see through the glass door. IF YOU LEAVE THIS DIRTY, A PROFESSIONAL OVEN CLEAN WILL COST £40+!



Fridge/ Freezer

Empty completely. Wipe down with anti-bacterial cleaner INSIDE, OUTSIDE AND ON TOP. Leave switched on with doors closed.



Microwave, Kettle & Toaster

Unplug before cleaning. Clean inside, outside and underneath. Remember to shake crumbs out of the toaster!



Taps and Sink

Use an anti-limescale cleaner to remove any white buildup on the taps – For ease, we recommend spraying Viakal and leaving for a few minutes before cleaning.



Floor and Walls

Thoroughly sweep the floor throughout and finish with a mop. Ensure any and all dried food is removed. Also check the walls and tiles for any grease and residue.

Bathroom



Shower screen

Clean using an anti-limescale remover to get rid of all white marks on the glass and runners (these are limescale build-up, and they will come off). We recommend using Viakal!



Shower, Bath, Taps & Tiles

Clean using Viakal (again) and an anti-bacterial bathroom cleaner – make sure to check the underside of the shower unit and the shower rope and remove any hair buildup from the plugholes. Anything orange or pink is body fat and product build-up. Please don't leave it behind!



Toilet

Clean INSIDE, OUTSIDE, AROUND & BEHIND using an anti-bacterial cleaner and bleach.



Floor

Sweep to remove any dust or stray hairs and mop with an anti-bacterial cleaner.



Windows and Mirrors

Clean and remove any residues from any windows and mirrors using either glass cleaner or washing up liquid and water.



Blinds

Clean blinds with soapy water and a sponge – DO NOT USE BLEACH.



Ceiling

Clean away any mildew spots (black spots) on your ceiling using a weak bleach or anti-mould cleaner.

Bedrooms



Beds (& Mattresses)

Hoover any hairs or dust from the bed frame, headboard & underneath mattress.



Carpet

Hoover entire room – Move all furniture inc. bed & wardrobe.
THIS WILL BE CHECKED WHEN YOU MOVE OUT.



Window

Clean window frame, sill & glass. Use either anti bac & glass cleaner, or washing up liquid and water.



Light switches, door handles & skirting boards

Wipe all touchpoints and woodwork clean with a damp sponge.



Drawers & Wardrobe

Hoover any dust from inside drawers, clean and wipe. Pull out all drawers and clean behind them.



Blinds

Clean binds with soapy water and a sponge – DO NOT USE BLEACH.



Desk & Chair

Make sure you have hoovered off your chair and wiped chair base and levers, as well as desk ON TOP AND UNDERNEATH.

IMPORTANT!

Remove ALL PERSONAL BELONGINGS BEFORE YOU LEAVE.
Anything left behind will be disposed of AT A COST.

Communal areas



Soft Furnishings

Hoover underneath all cushions and use fabric stain remover to remove any stains or food.



Carpet

Hoover entire room – Move all furniture inc. sofa and chairs.



TV and WIFI box

Dust and polish AROUND & BEHIND TV, WIFI box and any other items such as WIFI table.



Light switches, door handles & skirting boards

Wipe all touchpoints and woodwork clean with a damp sponge.



Windows

Clean all window frames and window glass using either glass cleaner or washing up liquid and water.



Blinds

Clean binds with soapy water and a sponge – DO NOT USE BLEACH.



Yard & Garden Areas

All external areas MUST BE CLEARED OF WEEDS AND RUBBISH before you leave the property. Please refer to your inventory to view the condition of the garden when you moved in and ensure this is the same as when you move out. Garden clearances can cost your deposit a lot of money!
